1.What documents are required to be submitted for admission?

At the time of applying for admission, you will need to have a colour scan of each of the original

Grade sheet of Class 10

Grade sheet of Class 12

Grade sheet of all the Semesters of bachelor's degree / Consolidated mark sheet (Only for PG Programs)

Degree Certificate / Provisional Degree Certificate (Only for PG Programs) Aadhar Card for Indian Nationals and Passport for Foreign Nationals

2.Is the Online Program recognized?

Yes, the University is Entitled by University Grants Commission (UGC) to offer Online Degree Programs. (UGC is the statutory body under the Ministry of Education, Government of India.)

Degrees at undergraduate and postgraduate level in conformity with UGC notification on Specification of Degrees, 2014 and postgraduate diplomas awarded through Online mode by Higher Educational Institutions, recognized by the Commission under these regulations, shall be treated as equivalent to the corresponding awards of the Degrees at undergraduate and postgraduate level and postgraduate diplomas offered through conventional mode.

7.Will I be able to interact with the faculty?


Yes, you will be able to communicate during live sessions as well as through the LMS discussion forum/chat.
